## SPRING PET CHECK LIST

- Toxic plants (house and garden)
- Flea Control
- Heartworm
- Tick control
- Worming up-to-date
- Vaccinations
- Grooming - shed the winter locks
- Check for grass seeds
- Check your leads and collars are ready for long spring walks
- Check local parks or beaches for Spring time opening hours
- Spring clean the kennel and pet beds
- Be prepared for seasonal allergies
- Keep an eye on the temperature outdoors
- Check your pet has shade during the day
- Make sure your pet has access to clean, fresh water
- Watch for Bees and other stinging insects
- Watch your cat with nesting birds (maybe get a bell collar)
- Keep household spring cleaning products away from your pets
- Make sure fertilisers and other spring gardening chemicals are not toxic
- Remember snail bait is poisonous!
